## **Tips for communicating with OMNI TA Team**

As we start out a new year, the OMNI TA Team wanted to share some updates and guidance for connecting with our team.

• Welcome back Jason! Jason Wheeler (he/his) has re-joined the OMNI TA Team, and will be responding to emails and working with CSBs throughout the year.



- OMNI Support email. Using the <u>OMNISupport@omni.org</u> email address to communicate with the OMNI TA Team is the most reliable, quickest way to receive a prompt response. Our entire TA Team will be able to see your email, and will reply as soon as possible.
  - Please use the OMNI Support email, rather than OMNI staff's individual email addresses.
- Phone calls. Sometimes, an actual conversation is the best approach instead of long, complicated emails. However, if possible, depending on the situation, it would be helpful to either schedule a call or reach out through our OMNI Support email.
  - Given that OMNI is still working 100% remotely, utilizing online video platforms, like Zoom, are still the easiest ways for us to connect.
- Contact person changes. If there is a staffing change within your CSB that impacts your prevention
  evaluation work, please let OMNI know by emailing <u>OMNISupport@omni.org</u>! We want to make sure
  we are reaching out to the correct person for evaluation and data entry needs.
- TA Team approach. OMNI has a team of 5 evaluation TA's to support your prevention work. Although you worked closely with one TA throughout the Block Grant and SOR Roadmap process, any one of the TA Team members will be able to assist you with evaluation and data entry support this year. Working with a team means always having someone available to respond to your question!

## **CSB Community Forum Discussions**



The OMNI TA Team will soon host community forums for CSBs to connect and learn from one another. Depending on the topic of the forum, staff from the DBHDS team may join the discussion as well.

The first forum in February will focus on OTC/stimulants to learn about strategies implemented in FY 19-20 among CSBs with OTC funding. ## **Community Spotlight**

# Northwestern CSB: *Everyone Has a Role* Media Campaign

Northwestern CSB implemented the far-reaching Everyone Has A Role media campaign promoting different actions individuals can take to prevent the spread of the opioid epidemic. The successful campaign was shared through billboards, radio and TV ads, and social media. Ads feature interview snippets with people in recovery from opiate misuse, and has segments targeting prescribers to inform them on patients' paths to



addiction, misuse in the home, the impact of trauma on addiction, naloxone use, and second chances to find recovery. Social media ads reached 46,588 individuals, with the most clicks from women ages 55+ and men ages 25-34 and 55-64. TV ads garnered over a half million impressions, and billboards delivered over 180,000 impressions per month as well.
