DBHDS Q&A Zoom Session Recap

Several members of DBHDS's OBHW team provided updates and responded to questions during a live Zoom session earlier this month. We appreciate the time and participation of so many DBHDS and CSB staff who helped make this format successful. Below are a few key takeaways from the discussion:



- Top priorities for DBHDS include:
 - Ensuring CSBs are supported and successful
 - Focusing on problem areas of Alcohol, Tobacco and Suicide Prevention/Mental Health
 - Spreading prevention messages
- 80/20 funding allocations for state identified vs. community identified strategies:
 - 80% of BG prevention funds should go towards the state-identified strategies
 - Collectively working on these across Virginia will allow us to see more progress towards outcomes
 - Reach out to Keith/Colleen if you have questions about your funding breakdown
- ACEs Interface virtual Training of Trainers is being developed and coming soon
- Counter Tools is allowing for flexibility and grace around meeting requirements
 - Safety is important! You do not need to resume retailer visits at this time if safety is a concern for your staff
 - Do not worry if visits didn't happen in 2019-2020, or are not able to happen now
 - No penalties for increases in state rates for 3 years due to Tobacco 21
- Lock and Talk trainings are available if needed reach out to Nicole Gore
- ASIST and safeTALK trainer trainings are on hold, and LivingWorks is granting a grace period for certification lapses
- Virtual MHFA does require a \$23.95 fee for participation

Coalition Assessment Webinar Recap

Thanks to all who attended our September Zoom Meeting to introduce you to the updated Coalition Readiness & Effectiveness Assessment tool and process. Here are some important points and resources from the presentation:

- The recording of the Zoom meeting, PowerPoint slides PDF, Coalition Assessment paper survey, toolkit, and codebook are all uploaded to <u>box.com</u> in the Block Grant Coalition Assessment Video and Supporting Documents section of the OMNI TA Resources for CSBs folder.
- The online version of the assessment is ready for you and your coalition to use! It is available electronically through the survey platform Qualtrics, and the link is in the toolkit.
- To test or preview the survey, please use this preview link only: PREVIEW
- Starting January 1, each CSB will be provided with an Excel spreadsheet with all survey responses to-date. The spreadsheet will automatically be uploaded to box.com in your CSB folder called Coalition Assessment Data quarterly. If you need data sooner, reach out to our team.
- A report with charted and graphed scores is in development. When ready, this will be automatically



uploaded to your Coalition Assessment Data folder as well.

Other points that you may find helpful:

- The goal is to have at least 75% of your membership complete the survey each time.
- All CSBs should administer at least one baseline assessment in FY2020-21.
- Allow a minimum of at least 6 months between assessments.
- Members taking the survey should not be brand new to the coalition and the coalition should have been together 4-6 months or more.
