

Fall 2021 | Central East (Region 3) SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION SKILLS TRAINING (SAPST)

COURSE REQUIREMENTS, LEVEL OF COMMITMENT, AND PARTICIPANT EXPECTATIONS

1. LEVEL OF COMMITMENT

The expected time commitment for this training is **31 hours**. Participants must complete the <u>entire</u> SAPST training to receive a certificate for 31 hours of participation. **No partial credit will be given**.

2. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

Your participation and engagement are very important in this virtual training. In order to participate fully, you MUST have access to the following items. Please verify that you are able to access each of these items BEFORE the first day of training.

- · Computer with a webcam, speaker, microphone, and Internet access
- Zoom Client for Meetings

 - You must use a computer to join Zoom. Do not join Zoom from a phone or tablet.
- Google Apps (specifically, Google Slides)

 - If you're unable to see the Google Slides document linked above, you do not have access to Google Apps. (We suggest trying another device if this is the case.)

3. PRE-SAPST COURSE

Completion of the 5-hour HealtheKnowledge online course, "Introduction to Substance Abuse Prevention: Understanding the Basics (Pre-SAPST Course)", is required prior to the training. Course certificates must be submitted online no later than 4 PM on Wednesday, November 24, 2021.

4. ORIENATION VIDEO

Participants must watch the 20-minute course orientation video, which includes a brief overview of SAPST, participant expectations, technology to be used during the training, how to prepare for the training, and information about completing homework assignments. Participants are required to complete four homework assignments. These assignments are submitted online via the SAPST Homework Portal on the day before each session. 9. POST-TRAINING EVALUATION

Participants will complete an online evaluation at the end of the training.

10. CERTIFICATE OF ATTENDANCE / CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS

Participants must complete the <u>entire</u> SAPST training to receive a certificate for 31 hours of participation. **No partial** credit will be given.

Certificate of Attendance will be issued within 30 days of the last day of training. Participants can then submit the certificate to their credentialing authority toward certification or re-certification. Please contact your certification board to determine if the virtual SAPST is applicable toward your certification requirements.

The IC&RC Prevention Committee has endorsed the SAPST as an IC&RC-approved curriculum. This endorsement provides assurance that the SAPST is applicable to IC&RC's prevention specialist domains and can be used toward the education/training requirement for IC&RC's Prevention Specialist credential. The SAPST has also been approved by NAADAC, the Association for Addiction Professionals.
