Charting a Course Forward: Evaluation Planning Updates

May is upon us! That means the FY2022-23 Evaluation Planning process is right around the corner. This is the OMNI TA Team's favorite time of year as it brings lots of one-to-one connection time with y'all as we prepare for another year of evaluation. As the end of the Block Grant fiscal year nears, we wanted to touch base on a few topics related to the Evaluation Roadmap and planning process.

FY21-22 PBPS Data Entry

Please ensure that data in PBPS are as up to date as possible! Entering data in an ongoing and timely manner avoids an end-of-year push by staff and also allows you time to correct rejected activities, ensuring that all your data will be accurate and included in end-of-year reporting. Please note these important dates:

- By **Friday**, **July 15th**, all Block Grant data, including activities for those strategies that blend funding with SOR, need to be entered.
- By **Friday**, **July 29th**, all rejections need to be addressed. Continue to check PBPS for rejected activities. The OMNI TA Team continually reviews activities and will do so throughout the rest of the fiscal year.

FY22-23 Evaluation Roadmap Process

Work on the FY22-23 Evaluation Roadmap will start in July - another reason to wrap up FY21-22 data entry early! This fiscal year, the Evaluation Roadmap process will look very similar to last year, with both Block Grant and SOR planning occurring in tandem. As always, the OMNI TA Team is flexible and can work with CSBs to complete evaluation planning that makes sense for your situation. We also recognize that many CSBs have added new staff this past year - if this process is new to you or someone on your team, rest assured that the OMNI TA team will work with you to ensure everyone is up to speed and comfortable with the evaluation planning process. Our Team will be reaching out to everyone soon with more information on the FY22-23 Evaluation Roadmap process and timeline. In the meantime, below are some steps your CSB can take to help prepare:

- Revisit your current Evaluation Roadmap and note anticipated changes to current strategies or new strategies you may implement in the coming fiscal year. You may need to meet with fellow CSB staff for input.
- Start gathering any data needed to show progress toward short-term outcomes for this year your short-term outcomes are listed in both your Logic Model and in your Measurement Plan(s).

Portal Registration and Two-Factor Authentication Reminders

Please check in with all prevention staff to make sure everyone has portal access.

To register, you will need a password provided by OMNI and to set up 2FA (Two factor authentication) either via email or an authenticator app on your phone.

Once you are registered in the portal, you can **choose which notifications you would like to receive**. To edit, go to "Members Home" and click "Edit Notifications." Here, select which types of updates you would like to subscribe to. You can always go back and add or change your subscriptions as needed.

Tip for Paper YAS Data Entry

We know that many of you are having great success during in-person administration. It's wonderful!

When you enter data from these paper surveys, please keep in mind that you do not need to enter surveys if the person is disqualified. Respondents are "disqualified" if they are under 18, over 25, or do not live in Virginia for most of the year. This will hopefully reduce data entry time.

through the Lock and Talk initiative and the efforts of the Suicide Prevention Alliance of Northern (SPAN) Virginia, the City of Alexandria Department of Community and



Human Services (DCHS) is collaborating with the Alexandria Circuit Court and the Alexandria Police Department (PD) to make free gun locks and medication locking devices broadly available. They are doing so in two new ways: (1) gun locks distributed to all Concealed Carry Permit applicants, and (2) Alexandria PD officers carry locking medication boxes in their vehicles and provide them directly to the community they serve.
