

FDA officially bans sale of Juul e-cigarettes in the US

The Food and Drug Administration on Thursday (June 23rd) ordered the popular Juul e-cigarette **pulled from shelves** — saying its maker, tobacco company Altria, submitted insufficient safety data.

The device, which uses disposable pods, accounts for **roughly 50%** of the e-cigarette market. According to a Gallup survey last year, about **6% of US adults** — or more than 15 million people — use e-cigarettes.

Richmond, VA – Attorney General Jason Miyares today submitted a bipartisan letter to Congress, joined by 21 other attorneys general, urging them to take action regarding copycat tetrahydrocannabinol, commonly known as THC, food
