Last Day of YAS Data Collection is TODAY!



We've reached the finish line! You have a few more hours to recruit folks before the 2024 Young Adult Survey closes. We wanted to pass on some important information:

- Slick Text and all QR codes and event links will be closed at the end of today.
- By now, you should have all paper surveys entered into the system. If you have not, alert OMNI ASAP!
- We recognize the importance of data in helping guide efforts at the community level. As such, our team can field requests for data at site or locality levels when response data allows us to do so without compromising the integrity of the data. If you are interested in receiving more local-level data, please complete <u>our request form</u>. Data requests will be met with a basic Excel file presenting survey results for specific sites and localities; it is a partial report with narrative and graphs. A minimum of 200 responses must be collected. This threshold ensures the reliability of data and minimizes the potential for participants to be identified based on responses. Other requirements are thoroughly detailed in the request form itself.

In closing, KUDOS for the hard work CSBs, prevention staff, coalitions, and volunteers have put in over the past three months. We have all learned so much and will build on our shared learning as we plan the 2026 Virginia Young Adult Survey! For now, OMNI will start our analysis process right away. A statewide comprehensive report will be available later this year, and there will be updates to the VASIS dashboard in the coming months at the state, region, CSB, and locality levels.

Reminder to Sign Up for Focus Groups to Help OMNI and OBHW Identify Priorities for the 2025-30 Block Grant Cycle!

OMNI Institute and OBHW are working together to conduct a statewide needs assessment to prepare for the upcoming 2025-2030 Block Grant cycle. These efforts, combined with a strategic planning process to take place next fiscal year, will serve to identify needs and prevention priorities at a state level, including identification of priority areas and strategies. Of course, we can't do this work without CSBs!

Virtual Group Information

OMNI is excited be hosting five 90-minute virtual focus groups for CSB prevention staff between April 18 and April 25th to hear from you all about your experiences, challenges, and ideas to help us shape the next five years of block grand funded prevention efforts. All responses will be kept confidential and either anonymized or rolled up with other responses into larger themes in reporting.

Run a *Stores Visited* report on the Query Builder

You can now pull a report for stores visited for all merchant education strategies using the Query Builder in the PBPS Evaluate Channel. To run this report, make sure to select "Stores Visited" in the Columns option in the Query Builder.

To do this, follow these steps:

- 1. Go to Evaluate
- 2. Select the Query Builder tab from the above menu
- 3. In Data Source, select
- "Activities"
- In the Date Range, select "Current State Fiscal Year"
- In Filters, select "Implement" in Activity Types; The current Counter Tools in Cohorts (You can select more information if you like)
- 6. In columns select: Stores Visited, Activity Date, Activity Description, and Contract name (You can select more information if you like)
- 7. Click Submit and it will ask
